Related Policies, Procedures, and Documents:

1. Purpose

1.1. This policy establishes the guidelines that limit guess access to certain Student's Union events.

2. Definitions

2.1. Member: A student registered in an undergraduate program at Wilfrid Laurier University who has paid all applicable fees.

3. Jurisdiction/Scope

3.1. This policy applies to all Students' Union programming, events, and facilities.

4. Policy

- **4.1.** When in effect, the Students' Union guest policy imposes limitations on the number of non-Wilfrid Laurier University student attendees at specified events.
 - **4.1.1.** Wilfrid Laurier University students will be required to present a valid OneCard in order to bring a guest(s).
 - **4.1.2.** Students' Union events may be limited to members of the organization, with no guests permitted.
 - **4.1.3.** Students' Union events may place a specific limitation on the number of guests that are permitted to accompany a member of the Students' Union to a specified event.
 - **4.1.4.** Students' Union events may limit guests to those individuals attending another post-secondary institution.
 - **4.1.4.1.** A valid student identification card will be required to confirm post-secondary attendance.
- **4.2.** Any guest attending a 19+ Students' Union event must present government-issued identification to verify their age.
