The Role

As a Faculty Advisor you are in an excellent position to help support our goal of guiding students through their leadership development and creating exceptional experiences for the students of Wilfrid Laurier University.

Eligibility

- With the approval of the Clubs and Associations Department, any Wilfrid Laurier University employee is eligible to serve as a Clubs and Associations Advisor.
- For one to qualify as a Faculty Advisor, the candidate must be employed by Wilfrid Laurier University. No restrictions exist as to the specific nature of the advisors' role.

Key Responsibilities

- To coach, guide, and mentor the club or association to achieve their desired mission and vision as identified in their approved constitution.
- Provide input and support where required.
- Share best practices with student leaders as they pertain to club or association activities.
- Support the club or association in adhering to the Clubs & Associations departmental policies and procedures including but not limited to financials and event timelines and submissions.
